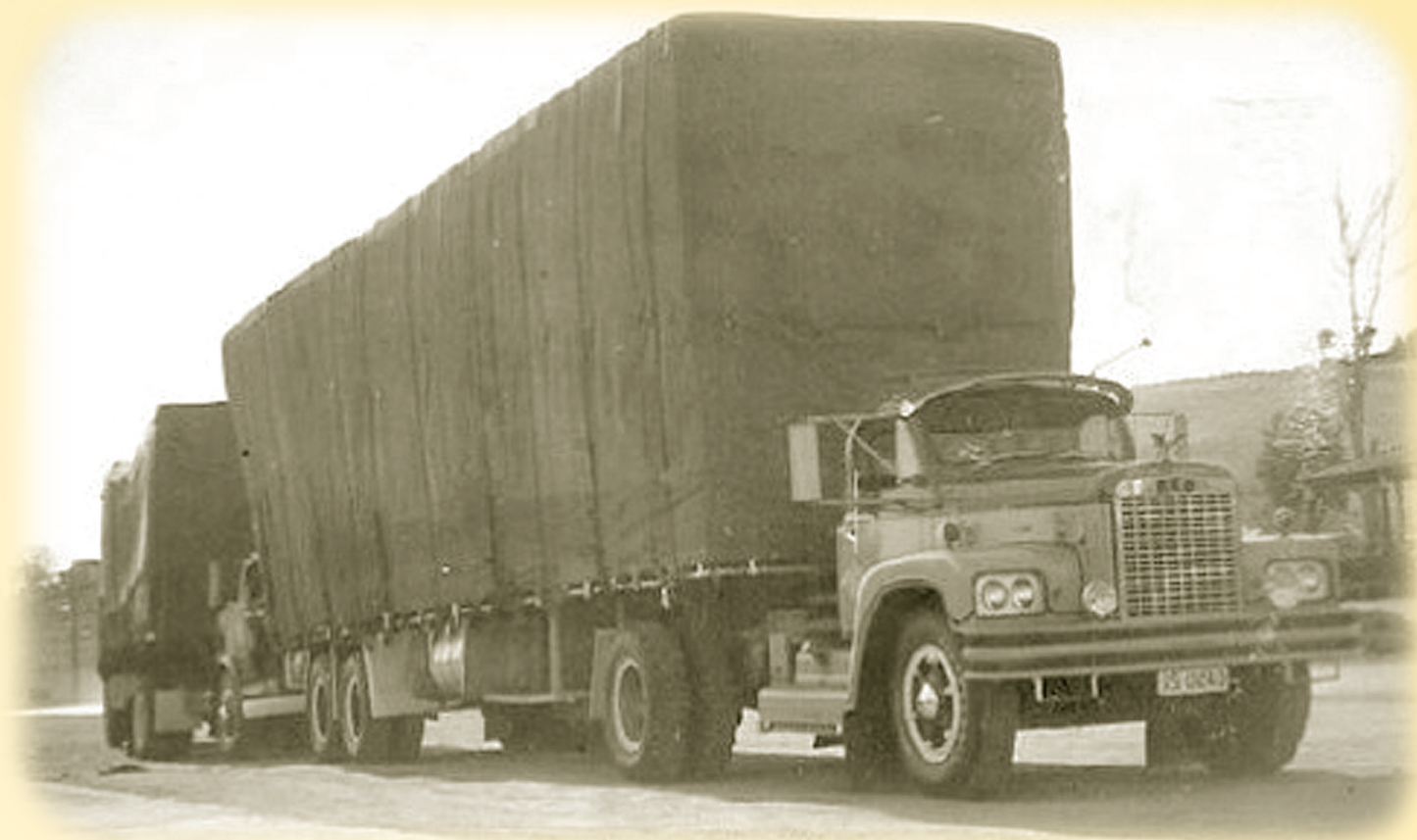




HAULIN' THE HUME
